RE: Public Records Act Request

Dear Ms. Harrington:

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.) and The Freedom of Information Act and its Amendments of 2007, HR 1309, introduced on March 5, 2007 and passed by congress on March 15, 2007, I ask to obtain a copy of the following, which I understand to be held by your agency:

1. The "**Work Plan**" for discovering buried hydraulic hoists and garage sump with fluids under the Shell service station located 230 S. Lincoln Ave., Corona, CA and the Valero (former Texaco) station located at 1610 W. Sixth Street, Corona, CA.
2. The "**Consultant's Report**" regarding the above Work Plan and stations if it is available now or as soon as it becomes available if you have not received it during the processing of this freedom of information request.

I ask for a determination on this request within 10 days of your receipt of it, and an even prompter reply if you can make that determination without having to review the records in question. If you determine that any or all of the information qualifies for an exemption from disclosure, I ask you to note whether, as is normally the case under either the State or Federal Acts, the exemption is discretionary, and if so whether it is necessary in this case to exercise your discretion to withhold the information. If you determine that some but not all of the information is exempt from disclosure and that you intend to withhold it, I ask that you redact it for the time being and make the rest available as requested.

In any event, please provide a signed notification citing the legal authorities on which you rely if you determine that any or all of the information is exempt and will not be disclosed.

If I can provide any clarification that will help expedite your attention to my request, please contact me by phone at (909) [deleted] or (909) [deleted] or by fax at: (909) 597-1295. I ask that you notify me of any duplication costs exceeding \$25 before you duplicate the records so that I may decide which records I want copied. If you can simply fax rather than trouble your agency to copy this request, please do so to the fax number above. In any event, thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
